## > MOTORIZED SCOOTERS

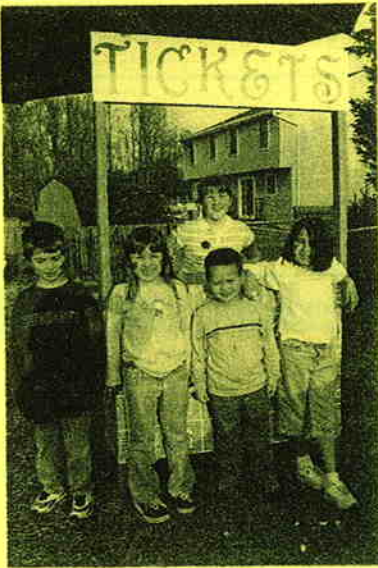

## > COMMUNITY YARD SALE

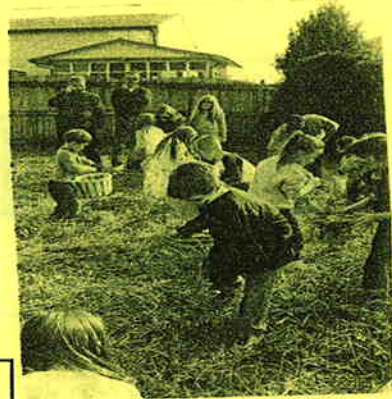

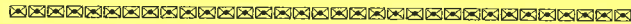

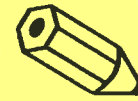
We are in need of people to serve on this committee to help keep our community maintained and showing proud occupancy.
