Revell Downs Sidewalk Reconstruction/Repair Project:

- 2-3 years to complete entire project comprised of Revell Downs community in its entirety
- Project commencement is approximately next week (week of 2/18/08) and begins with several blocks in RD being paint-marked for demolition/repair.
- 4x4 squares tagged for replacement/repair will be torn out, regraded with stone/pebble base, rebarred (2 steel bars in place to stabilize over tree roots and extend life of repair job), poured and set as weather permits... this is a 10-12 year solution versus taking down the trees which requires State of MD permits and is typically not an option given that our trees along our roadways have been determined to be NOT yet fully mature and therefore subject to preservation.
- Work will begin along a portion of Secretariat, TimTam Ct., Sham Ct., and Revell Downs Dr. first based upon phasing of the project and prior existing projects identified for these locations.
- NO ADDITIONAL WORK WILL BE DONE PER RESIDENT REQUEST OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF THIS PROJECT. Residents may speak with the contractors on-site in person to arrange for additional privately-funded work as desired but the County project will ONLY address damages caused by public thoroughfare trees (along roadside, not on private property) or utilities or those areas demonstrating a significant safety hazard.
- There will be NO curb or gutter replacements, just sidewalks.
- Approximately 4 trucks will be in/out of the neighborhood at any given time given the amount of concrete debris expected to be generated.
- **PLEASE** look out for vandalism of the completed work (before the cement has set/cured/dried fully) and report it immediately. Please inform your neighbors and your children that attempting to scratch initials, leave foot or handprints, defacing the work with obscene or offensive or gang-related tagging, etc. shall result in immediate Police action. The child's/person's description, etc. will be forwarded to the County Project Leader and to law enforcement personnel to address recuperating any costs involved in making emergency repairs. The vandalism occurring throughout the neighborhood MUST be stopped, at all levels. No Exceptions!!
